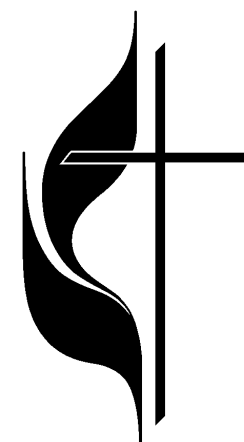

INDIANA CONFERENCE WEEK-END LOCAL PASTOR LICENSE SCHOOL

The School enables candidates to receive training when their primary vocation makes it difficult to attend a two-week residential school. The school provides the required contact hours of learning at times that make it possible for these persons to participate.

Admission Requirements

The Division of Ordained Ministry [Nashville, TN] requires that before acceptance in a licensing school a person must have been certified as a candidate for ordained ministry. This school is designed for persons who can best meet on week-ends because of his/her primary job.

Location and Schedule 2010

If you are serving a church you need to obtain someone to assume your responsibilities in the parish on the weekends that the school meets. All times are E.S.T. The interval between each weekend session provides time for persons to complete homework assignments.

Tuition

The tuition fee for the Weekend Local Pastor License School is \$ 550. (Tuition for persons from other than Indiana conferences is \$ 750.) The Indiana Conference pays \$ 275.00 of the tuition. Indiana conference registrants should pay \$ 100 with the application. The remaining tuition (\$ 175) shall be paid by January 22, 2010. Checks should be made payable to Indiana Weekend License To Preach School.

Students from conferences other than Indiana should pay at least \$ 375 with the application; the remainder shall be paid by January 22, 2010. Financial assistance may be available through your conference or district. Whole or partial refunds may be made for cancellations that are received before the opening day of the School. Other costs include travel, books, and personal items.

Attendance Policy

Attendance at all sessions is essential!

More than one day absence may require withdrawal from the school. If you serve a church, you will need to make arrangements to have your pulpit supplied on Sundays Jan. 24, Feb. 7, 28, Mar. 21. These Sundays cannot be counted as vacation days by either you or by your church. Your District Superintendent will assist you in making these arrangements if you need help.
