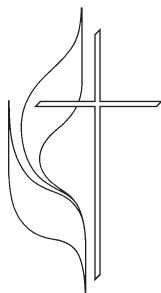


This Christmas, pray for all the children of the world.

Give to the Bishop's Christmas Offering

Funds received through the 2010 Bishop's Christmas offering will be allocated by percentages. The offering will be divided to meet needs in these children's ministries:

- Indiana Conference Camping program will receive 20 percent to go to first-time campers and children in need;
- Indiana United Methodist-related children and youth homes will receive 30 percent;
- Indiana Conference-related Operation Classroom will receive 10 percent;
- Local outreach projects will receive 20 percent;
- Bishop's fund for emergency children's projects will receive 10 percent;
- United Methodist Advance Projects (global and national) will receive 10 percent.

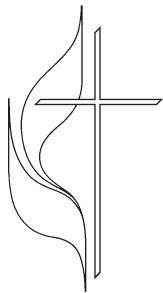
Programs supported by this offering are selected by the Indiana Conference Special Offerings Committee.
