

How is your portion of General Church Apportionments calculated?

1. From your statistical data reported at the end of each year there is an income reporting form called Table III. We start by taking your Table III line 67 Income figure. If your church did not submit your statistical data for the year ended 12/31/2009 we used the income figure from the last year your church did report.
2. We take the total of all churches Table III line 67. (For 2009 it is \$180,908,177)
3. We take the figure from item 1 above divided by item 2 above to come up with your church's prorated % of total conference income.
4. We take the % from item 3 above and multiply it times our General Church Apportionments for a given year – this is your church's portion of General Church apportionments.

If all churches paid a full tithe of their general operating income, this figure is how much of that full tithe would fund our General Church apportionments at 100%.
